

## CONTRIBUTION RULES

### § 1 Principles of the contribution regulations

1.1 The contribution regulations are not part of the statutes. It regulates the membership obligations as well as the fees and levies.

1.2 The membership fee regulations can only be changed by the general assembly of the association. Any changes made will be passed on to all members in writing as soon as possible.

### § 2 Resolutions and Notification

2.1, The general meeting on 09/21/2020 unanimously decided on the following new fee regulations, which will replace the old fee regulations from the general meeting on March 2, 2019 with immediate effect.

2.2 The membership fee regulations can be found next to the statutes on the website <http://humanbenefit.international> and are handed out as part of the membership application. This fee schedule is therefore binding.

### § 3 Regulation of membership fees

3.1 All club members pay a membership fee. The membership fee can be raised semi-annually or annually. Honorary members are exempt from paying membership fees.

3.2 Payment of the membership fee is made by transferring to the association account of "HumanBenefit International". Account holder:

3.3 The amount and due date of the membership fees currently resolved in the first version of the fee regulations at the above-mentioned general meeting are as follows:

	<b>annual payment</b>	<b>half-yearly payment</b>
<b>Membership fee from the age of 14</b>	36€ per year (Due date: March 1st of the current year)	18€ per ½ year (Due date: March 1st and September 1st of the current year)
<b>Legal persons</b>	60€ per year (Due date: March 1st of the current year)	30€ per ½ year (Due date: March 1st and September 1st of the current year)

3.4 The member has the choice of paying membership fees annually or every six months.

3.5 When joining the association, the remaining amount must be paid by the next due date.

3.6 In order to simplify and timely payment of membership fees, the member can authorize the association to debit the membership fees from the member's bank account every six months or annually. The direct debit authorization can be revoked and terminated at any time.

3.7 Resignation from the association is possible on a monthly basis by means of a written declaration.

3.8 Members are obliged to notify the office of any changes to address and account immediately in writing. If the changes are not communicated, the association can suffer disadvantages.

#### **§ 4 Solidarity principle**

The essential basis for the financial resources of the association is the membership fees. The association is therefore dependent on all members fulfilling their contribution obligations, which are basically regulated in the statutes (§ 5.1 of the statutes), in full and on time.
